Acceptable ID- Valid state or federal government issued photo ID, including a free ID Card issued by your county registrar's office* or the Georgia Department of Driver Services (DDS), GA Driver's License, even if expired, valid employee photo ID from any branch, department, agency, or entity of the U.S. Government, Georgia, or any county, municipality, board, authority or other entity of this state, Valid U.S. passport ID, Valid U.S. military photo ID, Valid tribal photo ID

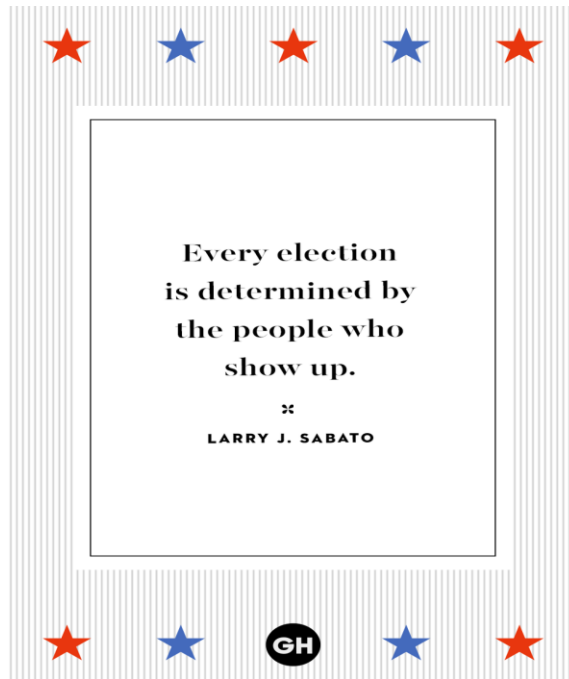
